

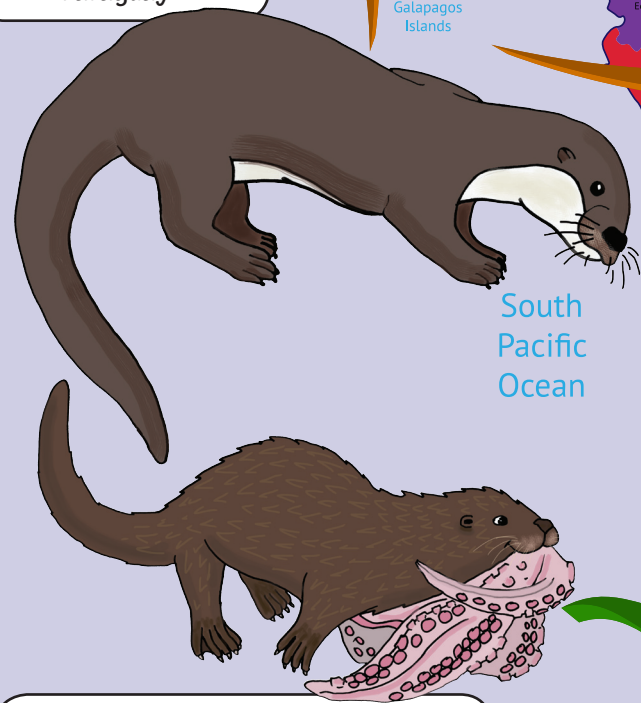
the OTTERS *of South America*

NEOTROPICAL OTTER
(*Lontra longicaudis*)
The second largest of the South American species, the Neotropical Otter is found in Northern Mexico down to Paraguay

GIANT OTTER
(*Pteronura brasiliensis*)
The largest of the South American species, the Giant Otter can reach up to 1.8 meters long and is found in South America, east of the Andes mountain chain

SOUTHERN RIVER OTTER
(*Lontra provocax*)
The second smallest of the South American species, the Southern River Otter is found in Chile and Argentina

MARINE OTTER
(*Lontra felina*)
The smallest of the South American species, the Marine Otter is found from Northern Peru along the Chilean coast down to Argentina.
